Here are some suggestions:



Men & Boys:

White shirt (somewhat loose)

Lace cravat (worn around the neck)

Waist coat (suit vest)

High white socks

Knee britches (base ball knickers or regular pants tucked into socks)

Powdered "wig" (use white yarn to braid a "ponytail" attach to a headband)

Tri-corn hat

Women & Girls:

White blouse (lace or ruffle trim may be added to collar or cuffs)

Long full skirt

White apron

Shawl, or vest

White mob cap or bonnet



****For both men and women, there are easy alternatives, such as flat coffee filters pinned in for ladies hats, or black construction paper stapled (perhaps with a feather) for men. Also, a white men's button-up shirt does well for both. Knickers can be made with sweatpants tucked into baseball socks, etc. Be creative and all will be well!****
